In the name of God amen I Zur Combs of the county of Highland and State of Ohio being weak of body but of sound mind and memory do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner following that is to say - First I will and bequeath to my son Robert W. Combs ninety acres of land off the upper and with the survey on which I now live together with the interest I hold in an adjoining survey claimed by the heirs of John Williams decd the division line to be run as follows beg'ing in the line of silas Georgs (the corner trees not necollected?) But known as a corner in the division of my estate thence N 17 W 11 poles to a whiteoak and dogwood thence N 75 W to Joseph P. Combs fence leaving said Joseph's fence one rod ?46 poles to a whiteoak in the line of William Garrett the said premises. I will to the said Robert W. Combs his heirs an assigns forever.

Secondly I bequeath to my son Joseph P Combs Eighty five acres more or less beginning at the Robert W. Combs corner in Garrett's line thence with the line of Robert W. Combs to a red oak and dogwood corner to Abner Jessup thence with Jessup's line to a white elm and stake corner to Jessup & Barrett thence to red oak dogwood & black haw thence to two white oaks and a stone thence to a black haw and a stone thence to a white oak & two dogwoods thence to two hickories in Garrett's line then to the beginning-

Thirdly to my daughter Barbara Ann Roads wife of Philip Roads I will and bequeath all the residue of my farms supposed to contain seventy four acres to her and her heirs forever on the following condition that is to say she the said Barbara Ann Roads and Philip her husband shall cultivate the farms in a husband like manner and shall deliver to Mary Combs my present wife one third part of all the grain the farm my produce small gain thrashed & cleaned all corn cribs and shall moreover furnish forage for one cow and eight sheep if she the widow shall as many also shall allow her full possession of the mansion house and half the kitchen her natural life and furnish her with fewel? and one third of the produce of the orchard - but if the said Barbara Ann and Philip her husband shall fail to comply with the above stipulations then the said Mary Combs shall have power to enter said premises and take full possession thereof for her sole benefit.

Fourthly - to my son Jacob H. Combs I will and bequeath one hundred and fifty dollars to be paid by Barbara Ann Roads and Philip her husband in two years after they get clear and full possession of the farm ?? By this will after bequeath to them the \$150 to be paid in good property.

Fifthly to Eliza R. Plumer I bequeath one one hundred and forty dollars to be paid in good property as above by said Barbara Ann and Philip Roads in two years after they get possession of said farms.

Fifthly To the heirs of my daughter Deboraugh Darnall viz? Anderson and Alford I will and bequeath to each ten dollars to be paid out of any monies not appropriated arising from my estate.

Sixthly- To my son John M Combs I will one dollar

Seventhly To my daughter Barbara Ann Roads I will my wagons harrow burstier plow & 3 pair of horse gear.

Eighthly To my wife Mary Combs I will and bequeath two beads bedding & bedsteads and one bureau

Ninthly It is my will that Philip Roads shall have the privilege of making two thousand nails and ten years of finewood taken off Robert W. Combs lot but in such a manner as to do the least possible injury

Tenthly I will and bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Rockhold the entire residue of my property entire after just and legally demanded debts are paid.

Lastly I herreby appoint my son Robert W. Combs executor to my last will and testament. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this fifteenth day of April of ?A. 1828.

"Uncle Bobby" Combs, mention of whose serious illness was made in these columns recently, died at the "old Combs place" Sunday morning, of old age and general debility. Funeral services were held in the Methodist Church at Midway on Monday morning, the Rev. Boatman officiating. "Uncle Bobby", as he was familiarly called, was probably the oldest settler in North Fulton and was one of the men who pitched their tents among the trees and wild grasses that waved in the breezes for hundreds of years undisturbed, and helped subdue the wilderness and convert it into what we now behold. We owe a debt of gratitude to those who pioneered Fulton County which can never be repaid.
